

How Well Can We work Together ~ Cooperative Learning Activity

Instructions:

1. Divide your group into teams of 4/5.
2. Each team is required to find ten words that fit the descriptions for that word.
3. For example: What word rhymes with CHAR, makes a phrase with SHOOTING and when spelled backwards means TATTLES (slang)?
4. The answer is STAR (RATS).
5. This is a race against time and one that requires members to work together.
6. When the groups are divided, explain that they will be given 7 minutes to find 10 words. (optional: Team winners will share a pack of M&M's)
